The National House Project - @TheNationalHP

The National House Project was incorporated as a Charity in August 2018. It provides support and expertise to local authorities around the country to set up and manage Local House Projects so that young people leave care in a planned and supported way.

Islington House Project

Islington House Project started in 2018 as one of the first pilots and is still going strong! It has recently expanded so that more young people can experience the House Project approach and move in to their first home in a more supported way.

They create meaningful opportunities in five key areas working with organisations across England and support care leavers to access these opportunities. They work with the National House Project to facilitate access to these opportunities for the young people they work with.
