

Eligibility Criteria

In order to apply for Aspirational Awards you will need to:

- Be living in your own home
- Have undertaken units within the House Project Programme
- Be able to explain how the award will impact on your future
- Have discussed your application with a member of staff from your local House Project who is willing to support you with your application and plan if successful
- The panel will consider video or voice note applications, but these must contain the same information as the form and as much detail as possible

What can I apply for?

The panel will consider any application that is really aspirational for **example** it might be educational, around employment or improving life prospects. Aspirational things are ambitious, like a goal you're aiming for.

- A young person may apply for an award, even if they have been granted an award previously. However the panel may take into consideration those that have yet to receive an award first.
- The panel will not consider applications for driving licences, driving lessons or motor vehicles.
- For travel applications these must have significant impact for that young person. It has to evidence additionality rather than just a holiday. For example this could be a trip to support employment opportunities or a trip to volunteer and gain new skills.
- If applying for funding for a business and NEET, support can initially be sought from The Princes Trust outside of the NHP timeframe.
- Application forms should include as much information as possible including costings
- If there is insufficient information to make decisions applications will be returned and further information requested.

There is no maximum value you can apply for. In the first round we awarded over £21,000 in awards ranging from £105 to £5000

If successful in your award, you will be expected to have made use of the award within twelve months, unless there are extenuating circumstances for it to be extended.







Other funding routes
